



Job Description – Senior Coach

Salary: £360 - £490 per week dependent on age, qualifications and experience.

A Senior Coaches role throughout the day is to assist the Camp Manager in delivering a professional and fun environment. You will be required to lead groups and activities in a fun and safe manner. As a Senior Coach you will be expected to use your incentive to ensure games are adapted to suit your group demographic whilst not veering away from the core structure laid out in the how to guides.

Part of your role will be to proactively help in pre-planning the day's activities with the Camp Manger. You must be available to assist the Camp Manager in all tasks and provide feedback when required.

Throughout camp, you must portray a fun, professional and approachable demeanor whilst ensuring all safeguarding policies are adhered to. You must be able to act with initiative when needed to manage situations.

Key Responsibilities

- Set up and pack down activities and venues.
- Assist with planning and deliver sports and A+C activities.
- Supervise mega activities.
- Monitor ratios and report to CM where staffing needs to be adjusted.
- Help maintain a clean and tidy site throughout the day.
- Following policies and procedures to create a safe and fun environment.
- With the help of the Camp Manager, you will plan and deliver exciting and safe sessions that are age-relevant.
- Provide safety instructions and demonstrations of equipment and ensure these are adhered to.



- Get to know the children at camp and make their sessions engaging to ensure the quality of service.
- Checking the Activity and Arts & craft equipment efficiently and regularly and requesting stock refills where needed.
- Reporting any safeguarding concerns.
